1. This tournament is sanctioned by the Badminton Association of Western Australia (Inc) (Badminton WA) and except where otherwise stated it will be conducted in accordance with the Laws of Badminton and Tournament Regulations adopted by the Badminton World Federation.
2. The management of the entire tournament will be in the hands of the Badminton WA Tournament Committee and the appointed Referee and they reserve the right to add to or alter these conditions as necessary.
3. **Each player must fully complete and submit his or her entry on the Entry Form for this event. Players shall enter Grades according to their Grading shown on the website or, if not graded, then according to the criteria shown on this Entry Form.**
4. **A PLAYER MAY NOT ENTER MORE THAN 3 EVENTS ACROSS TWO GRADES.**
5. Entry forms must be received by the Tournament Committee by the closing date, as specified, and Badminton WA takes no responsibility for late receipt of entry forms.
6. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to move a players' entry to a particular grade or division that is considered to be more reflective of the player's standard. The player will be advised of this.
7. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to cancel an event for which there are insufficient entries.
8. A player must report to the Match Desk 15 minutes before the scheduled time of his/her first match.
9. **ENTRY FEES are to be paid on arrival- prior to the player taking to the court.**
10. A player participating in the tournament must act as an umpire or line judge if called upon. The loser is expected to umpire the next match on that court. All players are required to act as Line Judges.
11. **All events in the tournament will be KNOCK OUT format where there are MORE than 8 entrants.**
12. Players must wear white-soled (non-marking) shoes and appropriate badminton attire in accordance with BWF Tournament Regulations.
13. Feather shuttles will be used for all events.
14. The FIRST TIMES will be on the website and will be displayed on the noticeboard at the Kingsway Stadium from Wednesday 23rd June.
15. The first matches on each day will commence at 9.15am
