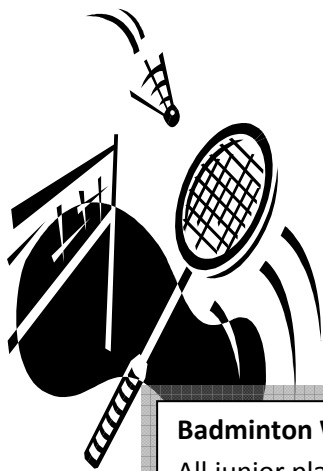




You are invited to register for the

Badminton WA is pleased to organise the 2011 Junior Pennant to start on Saturday, 13th August .

All junior players are invited to join this fun filled team competition. The matches will run for a total of 4 Saturdays up to 3rd September. It is open to all juniors between 8 and 19 yrs old.

All Junior Players are invited to submit their registration by Monday, 8th August to participate in this Junior Pennant season. The matches will be played at Karrinyup Sports Centre, Nerita Way, Karrinyup between 2 to 4 pm on Saturday afternoons.

Teams will be made up from registered male and female players to play round robin games over the four weeks. The teams at the top of the table after Week 3 will play for the Championship. Team selections will be made to ensure that there is even competition between all teams and players. Both singles and doubles games will be played with feather shuttlecocks.

Registration fees is \$50 / player for the 4 weeks. Trophies will be awarded to the champion and runner up teams.
