## CURTIN BADMINTON OPEN TOURNAMENT 2011

### RULES & REGULATIONS

COMMITTEE: FEIFEI HE, GASTON CHEUNG, JONATHAN TUKIMIN, KANGSHENG LOH, KELVIN TUI,  
TUSHAR AGARWAR

1. This tournament is sanctioned by the Curtin Badminton Association (CBA) and except where otherwise stated it will be conducted in accordance with the Laws of Badminton and Tournament Regulations adopted by the Badminton World Federation.
2. The management of the entire tournament will be in the hands of the CBA Tournament Committee and the appointed Referees and they reserve the right to add or alter these conditions as necessary.
3. Each player must fully complete and submit his or her entry on the Entry Form for this event. Players shall enter the appropriate Divisions (intermediate/advanced) according to the grading below:

**GRADING: If you do not have a Badminton WA grading you should consider the following:**

**OPEN Grade = International player, National player, State player, top club player**

**A Reserve Grade = Good club player**

**B Grade = Sound competitive player**

**C Grade = Social competitive player**

4. **PLAYERS MAY ONLY ENTER 1 DIVISION AT A TIME. OR ENTER A UPPER GRADE.**
5. **ENTRIES CLOSE 10<sup>th</sup> SEPTEMBER.** Entry forms must be received by the Tournament Committee by the closing date, as specified, and CBA takes no responsibility for late receipt of entry forms.
6. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to move any individuals or pairs to a particular division that is considered more reflective of the person's/persons' standard. The players will be advised of this.
7. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to cancel an event for which there are insufficient entries.
8. Players must report to the Match Desk **15 minutes** before the scheduled time of his/her first match.
9. **ENTRY FEES** are to be paid upon submission of the entry form to any organizing committee members, receipts will be issued.
10. A player participating in the tournament must act as an umpire or line judge if called upon. The loser is expected to umpire the next match on that court. All players are required to act as Line Judges.
11. All events in the tournament will be either **Round Robin** or **Knock-Out** depending on the number of participants. Players will be advised of the format beforehand.
12. Players must wear white-soled (non-marking) shoes and appropriate badminton attire in accordance with BWF Tournament Regulations.
13. Feather shuttles will be used for all events.

I will abide by the rules and regulations set forth by the Tournament Committee for Curtin Badminton Open Tournament 2011 and to uphold the spirit of goodwill and sportsmanship for the duration of the tournament.
