COMPETITION RULES

- A. Teams consist of a minimum of 2 men and 2 women and maximum of 3 men and 3 women.
- B. No player may play in more than one team.
- C. Players must be ranked according to ability and will hold that rank for the duration of the competition. Strongest player ranked #1.
- D. Singles can be played by any player – and this can change each Tie.
- E. A Tie will consist of 8 matches, total of 15 games (each game to 21 points, no setting):

Match 1. Men's Singles (2 games)	Match 2. Women's Singles (1 game)
Match 3. Men's Doubles (2 games)	Match 4. Women's Doubles (2 games)
Match 5. Mixed Doubles 4 th pair(2 games)	Match 6. Mixed Doubles 3 rd pair (2 games)
Match 7. Mixed Doubles 2 nd pair (2 games)	Match 8. Mixed Doubles 1 st pair(2 games)
- F. No player may play in more than 3 matches in any tie.
- G. The Clubs and Associations entering several teams are asked to rank their teams in order of ability, Team #1 being the strongest.
- H. The placing of teams into Divisions and the finalisation of the Draw format will be done by the Organising Committee once all entries have been received.
- I. Results will be based on GAMES WON in a Tie.
- J. Final placings will be determined by:
 - 1. Most GAMES won
 - 2. If two teams have EQUAL GAMES WON, then the team winning the most games in the head-to-head will be the winner.
- K. If GAMES are equal among 3 or more teams then the team with the least points scored against them – only from the Ties involving these teams- will be declared the winner.
- L. Metro players can only be used to fill teams – they cannot be the majority of players in a team. No more than 2 metro players (1 man and 1 woman) can be used to fill any team.
- M. A metro team may be entered by the Organising Committee if it is felt this will improve the competition – e.g. to make an even number of teams.

BADMINTON WA MEMBERSHIP

All players who are not current registered members of Badminton WA are required to pay \$15 event membership fee.

PHOTOGRAPHY AT THE EVENT

Photos and videos of participants, guests and spectators may be taken during the event, and may be subsequently used in Badminton WA publications and online resources. By entering the event you agree to such use of the photos / videos. Due to the way events are run it is not possible to guarantee that any one individual is never captured in any of the photos / videos taken. If you do not want a photo or a video where you feature as one of the main subjects to be used in Badminton WA publications and online resources, please make this known to the match desk when first entering the venue on your arrival to the event.
