Two divisions:

- Division A for teams which include one or more players graded A or A Reserve;
- Division B for teams with no players above B Grade.

This event is only for clubs affiliated with Badminton WA. All players must be members of the club. A club may enter multiple teams. If your club happens to be a men's only or a women's only club, please get in touch with us ASAP and we'll try to find a solution.

Teams to have a minimum of 6 players (4 men + 2 women) and maximum of 8 players (5 men + 3 women).

Entries are limited to 8 teams per division; please enter early to ensure your place in the tournament. The second team from the same club into the same division will be allowed if there are vacancies in the draw.

## COMPETITION RULES

- A. Teams consist of a minimum of 4 men and 2 women and maximum of 5 men and 3 women.
- B. No player may play in more than one team.
- C. Players must be ranked according to ability (men and women ranked separately) and will hold that rank for the duration of the competition, except when the ranking order is clearly inconsistent with the relative strength, as determined by the Referee.
- D. A Tie will consist of 7 matches:
  - 1. First Singles (men or women; a handicap rule may be applied at the Referee's discretion before the commencement of the tie if a woman is playing against a man)
  - 2. Second Singles (men or women; same handicap rule)
  - 3. First Men's Doubles
  - 4. Second Men's Doubles
  - 5. Women's Doubles
  - 6. First Mixed Doubles
  - 7. Second Mixed Doubles
- E. Any player is allowed to play in no more than one match in each discipline (e.g. one MD/WD + one XD + one Singles).
- F. Singles can be played by any of the players – and this can change in each Tie.
- G. The playing order in a Tie may be changed if both Captains agree.
- H. Scoring format will be determined by the organisers depending on the number of entries received / rounds required.
- I. The event will start at 9am and finish approximately at 5pm.

## PHOTOGRAPHY AT THE EVENT

Photos and videos of participants, guests and spectators may be taken during the event, and may be subsequently used in Badminton WA publications and online resources. By entering the event you agree to such use of the photos / videos. Due to the way events are run it is not possible to guarantee that any one individual is never captured in any of the photos / videos taken.
