

DISCIPLINARY POLICY

Section 23 of the Badminton Association of WA Inc. CONSTITUTION deals with MEMBERS DISCIPLINARY PROCEDURE

This Disciplinary Policy confirms the details as outlined in the Constitution.

Note:

The reasons for disciplinary action are shown as:

- a) A breach of the Constitution or the Bylaws of the BAWA and/or any affiliated association of club;
- b) An act of unbecoming conduct; or
- c) An act which is detrimental to the interest of BAWA or affiliated association or club;
- d) An act which is detrimental to the game of badminton.

Penalties (as shown in the Constitution) can be:

- Expulsion from the BAWA
- Suspension from the BAWA
- Penalties as deemed fit.

The Disciplinary procedure shall follow :

- a) For a minor breach: a meeting between the party involved and two Board Members. Board Members to report to the Board.
- b) Anything further shall follow the procedure as shown in the Constitution.
