The Badminton WA Junior Umpires Awards Programme aims to nurture, educate and develop juniors aged 13 to 17 with the vision of becoming a court official. By attending the training session on selected Laws of Badminton and completing both the written theory test and practical assessment at the BAWA tournaments, the successful candidate will be awarded the certificate to the appropriate level. This is the first step for juniors towards becoming qualified umpires.

### Certification Requirements

To be awarded with the Bronze Certificate, the candidate must volunteer umpire at least two games at the Kingsway Tournament on 18<sup>th</sup> - 19<sup>th</sup> February 2017, attend the training session and pass the written theory test, and pass the practical assessments. The next two tournaments for assessment are:

LiveLighter Autumn Tournament 8-9 April 2017

LiveLighter State Junior Championships 13-16 July 2017

Whilst candidates are encouraged to take part in the practical assessments at the following tournaments, if unable to attend, the practical assessment can also be carried out in tournaments in the second half of year 2017.
