#### Weather:

Mandurah's July weather is consistent, with daily forecasts of between 17-21 degrees and overnight lows between 9 and 13 degrees with 73% humidity.

July is the wettest month of the year with 118.2 mm of rain falling in 2018, so come prepared so you can enjoy many of the winter activities on offer.

Winter in Mandurah is a magical time, where rivers rise and the whole region offers a wide range of winter activities. Some recommended activities include,

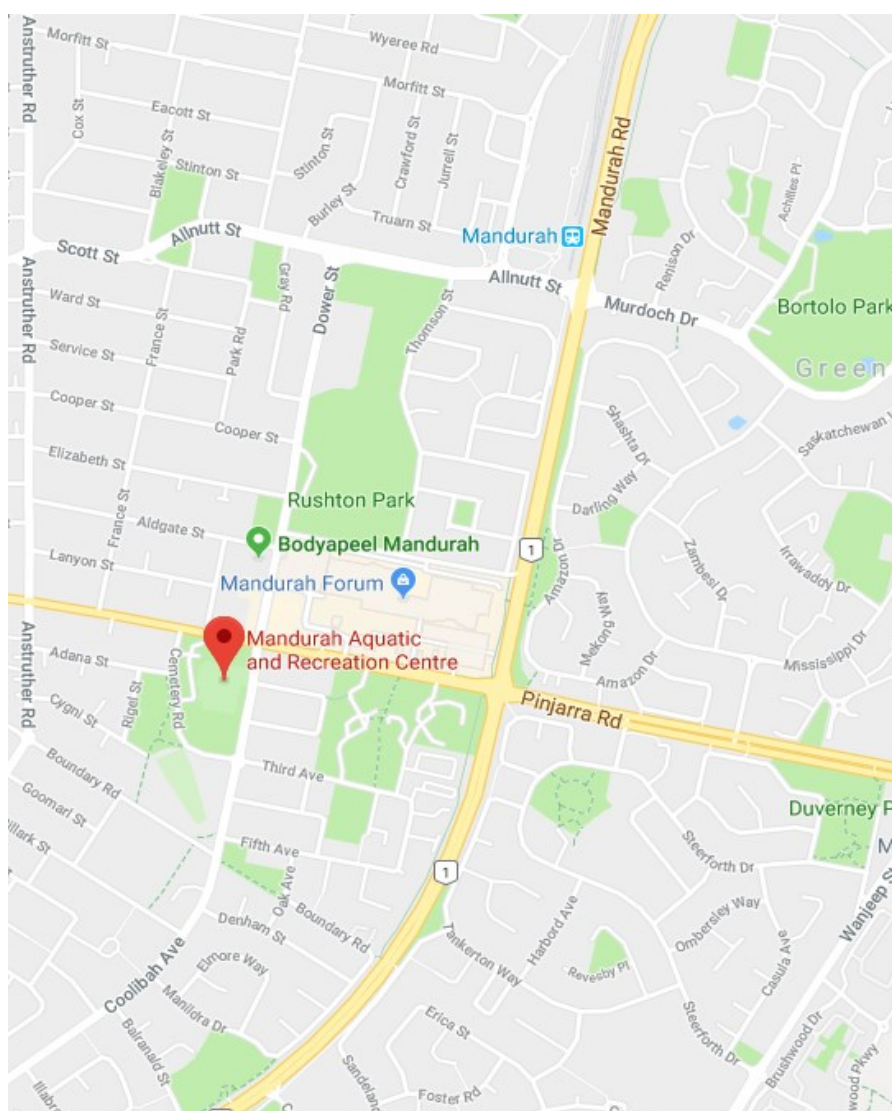

Transport

The average travel time between Mandurah and Perth City Centre is about one hour with regular fast rail services and major roads connecting the two cities.

The Kwinana Freeway is the most direct route from Perth and leads directly into Mandurah from the Mandjoogoordap Drive exit (pronounced ‘Mand-joo-GOOR-dap’).

For a more leisurely and scenic drive take the South Western Highway alongside the Darling Ranges.
