COMPETITION REGULATIONS

A. State Junior Championships

- 1. Each player must complete and submit his or her entry and pay entry fee online using the Tournament Software website.
- Age Divisions are: U11, U13, U15, U17.
- 3. Players may not enter below the correct age division, that is, below the age the player will be as of 31st December 2017. E.g. if a player was born in 2004, they cannot play U13 and must enter U15 or U17 division.
- 4. **PLAYER TIME EXEMPTIONS WILL NOT BE GRANTED.** By entering the event the player is agreeing to be available to play on both days from 9am until the last match.

B. Higgs Trophy Team Event

- 1. Teams must consist of 3 players and at least one member must be female. A team tie will include 3 singles and 3 doubles matches.
- 2. Age Divisions are: U11, U13, U15, U17. The tournament organisers reserve the right to combine or review the age divisions based on the number of entries received.
- 3. No player can play below their age division e.g. a player who is turning 13 this year cannot play in an U11 or U13 team and must play in an U15 or U17 team.

C. General Regulations

- 1. This tournament is organised by The Badminton Association of Western Australia (Inc) (Badminton WA) and except where otherwise stated it will be conducted in accordance with the BWF Laws of Badminton and General Competition Regulations.
- 2. The management of the entire tournament will be in the hands of the Badminton WA tournament organisers and the appointed Referees and they reserve the right to add to or alter these rules and other conditions as necessary.
- 3. The format of draws and the scoring system will be determined by the organisers depending on the number of entries and considering time / court restrictions. Where possible the preferred scoring system will be BWF standard scoring (best of 3 games to 21 points with setting, rally point scoring). Where possible, the first stage draws will be round robin with a minimum of 3 players / pairs.
- 4. Feather shuttles will be provided for all events.
- 5. Players must wear non-marking shoes and appropriate badminton attire in accordance with BWF General Competition Regulations.
- 6. Entries close on Sunday 25th June 2017. Late entries will not be accepted.
- 7. The organisers reserve the right to cancel an event for which there are insufficient entries.
- 8. If a player withdraws an entry before or on the entry closing day (Sunday 25th June 2017), a full refund of the entry fee will be issued.
- 9. If a player withdraws after the closing date, or in case of a no show, refunds will not be issued unless a doctor's certificate is provided. If a certificate is provided, the entry fee will be refunded, withholding \$10 administration fee.
- 10. If a player's entry has been cancelled by the organisers (e.g. if a player could not be allocated a doubles partner, or her/his double partner withdraws, or an event has been cancelled due to insufficient entries), the entry fee for such events will be refunded. The players will be advised of the cancellation via the published draw.
- 11. Should a player be entered in more than one event, by retiring or withdrawing from that one event, the player must be withdrawn from all others events in which the player is entered.
- 12. Any player participating in the tournament must act as an umpire or line judge if called upon.
- 13. Schedule may be changed during the event subject to player involvement and other factors; the players are asked to check their matches schedule regularly, including after the end of the Saturday playing sessions.
- 14. All players must be ready to play at least 15 minutes prior to their scheduled match time.
- 15. The first matches on each day will commence at 9am unless advised otherwise.

D. Photography at the Event

Photos and videos of participants, guests and spectators may be taken during the event, and may be subsequently used in Badminton WA publications and online resources. By entering the event you agree to such use of the photos / videos. Due to the way the events are run, it is not possible to guarantee that any one individual is never captured in any of the photos / videos taken. If you do not want a photo or a video where you feature as one of the main subjects to be used in Badminton WA publications and online resources, please make this known to the match desk when first entering the venue on your arrival to the event.
