- Sanctioned by:** Badminton World Federation (BWF); Badminton Oceania; Badminton Australia
- Regulations:** The tournament will be conducted in accordance with the BWF General Competition Regulations (BWF GCR), BWF Junior Competition Regulations (BWF JCR) and Badminton Oceania Guidelines for Grade 3 Events and Junior International Events. In the event of any dispute, the decision of the Referee will be final.

- Event dates:** Thursday 13th September – Sunday 16th September 2018.
Please note that this event is held in conjunction with **Asia-Pacific Under 19 Team Championships** which will take place on Tuesday 11th – Wednesday 12th September 2018 at the same venue.
- Venue:** Kingsway Indoor Stadium (130 Kingsway, Madeley WA 6065, Australia).
Court surface is wood sprung floor.
- Prize money:** USD\$2,000. Distribution: winners - USD\$260; runners-up - USD\$140 for each event. In case of doubles events, these amounts will be split between the doubles partners. The prize money will be paid in cash directly to the players in local currency (AUD), rounded to whole dollars. Any applicable tax will be the responsibility of the players.
- Entries close:** **International entries** close Tuesday 14th August 2018, 23:59 hours BWF HQ/AWST time (+8:00GMT).
Australian entries close Tuesday 7th August 2018, 23:59 hours BWF HQ/AWST time (+8:00GMT).
No late entries will be accepted.

How to enter:

International entries are accepted from BWF Member Associations only. Member Associations are advised to log in to Australian Junior International on Tournament Software. Online entry short link for international entries: <https://goo.gl/uV9ue5> (case-sensitive). You'll need to use your Member Association's existing online entry login and password to submit the entries. If your Member Association doesn't have a login / password for the BWF Online Entry System, please contact Senior Events Officer Shan Ramachandran s.ramachandran@bwfbadminton.org. After the closing date, the BWF Online Entry System will send a notification confirming reception of final entries to all participating Member Associations. Receipt of this notification is the conclusive evidence of reception of entries before the deadline. Member Associations should contact BWF immediately if such notice is not received by Wednesday 15th August 2018 by 12:00 hours (noon) BWF HQ/AWST time (+8:00GMT). If no objection is received by BWF by Thursday 16th August 2018 by 23:59 hours BWF HQ/AWST time (+8:00GMT), the entries shall be deemed to be correct and no complaints / objections will be entertained after this point.

Australian entries are accepted online using Tournament Software only. Online entry short link: <https://goo.gl/iLnxgB> (case-sensitive). All Australian players are required to enter using their BWF Member ID number. If an Australian player doesn't have a BWF Member ID number, they must contact baentryofficers@gmail.com, allowing up to 3 working days for the Member ID to be issued.

Players must be under 19 years of age (born on 1st January 2000 or later).

Presentation:

All prize giving ceremonies will take place on Sunday at the conclusion of the Finals.

Practice Courts:

Practice courts at the competition venue will be available from Monday 10th September 2018. Please complete the Practice Courts Booking Form and email it to aji2018@badmintonwa.org.au.

Shuttles:

Aeroplane Black EG1130, two speeds (51 & 52) will be available. Each tournament player will be provided two practice shuttles free of charge. Additional shuttles may be purchased from the Organiser.

- Clothing:** Clothing and advertising requirements according to BWF JCR. **Player name on the shirt is mandatory (BWF Statutes Section 5.3.7).** Country name is optional but if present, it must comply with the BWF JCR.
- Doping Control:** The BWF Anti-Doping Regulations apply (www.bwfcorporate.com/integrity/anti-doping/). Players competing in this tournament are subject to drug testing by the Australian Sports Anti-Doping Authority (ASADA). Applicable rules, list of prohibited substances and methods, and the “check your substances” tool is available at www.asada.gov.au.
- Accommodation:** Official tournament hotel is Quality Resort Sorrento Beach – please see next page.
- Transportation:** Please arrange to arrive to the Perth International Airport. Airport transfers for arrival and for departure will be provided for players and team officials staying at the tournament hotel (Quality Resort Sorrento Beach). Transport Request Form must be emailed to aji2018@badmintonwa.org.au no later than Thursday 6th September 2018.
Daily bus transfers between the tournament hotel and the stadium will be organised, with schedule displayed at the tournament hotel and at the stadium.

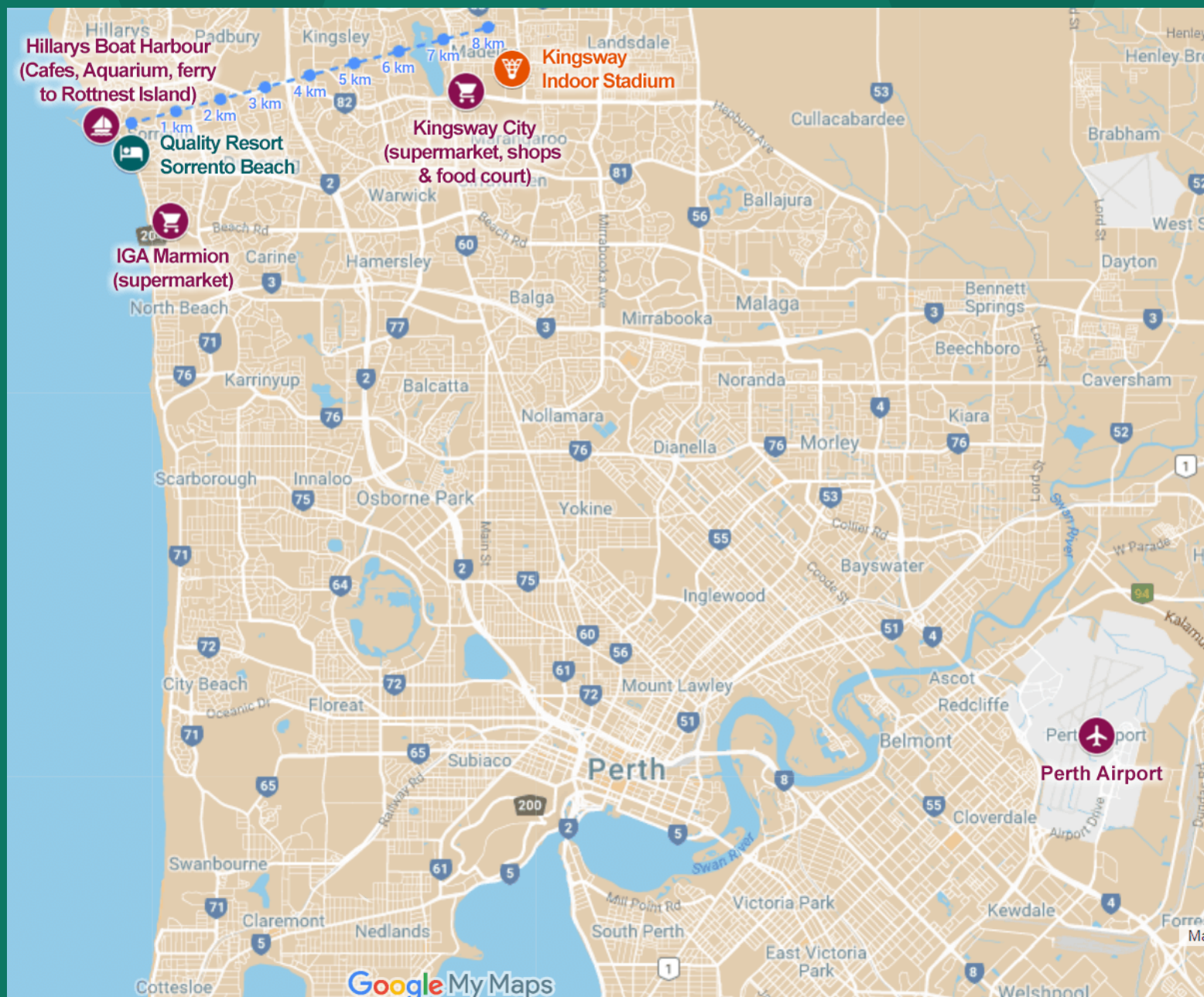

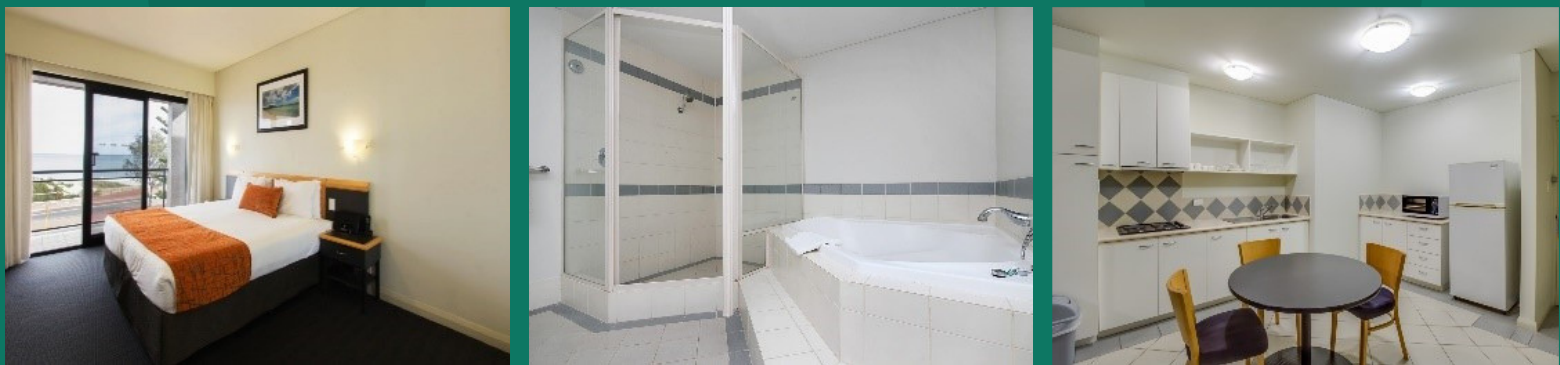
