- Sanctioned by:** Badminton Australia
- Regulations:** The tournament will be conducted in accordance with the BWF General Competition Regulations (BWF GCR) and Junior Competition Regulations (BWF JCR). In the event of any dispute, the decision of the Referee will be final.

- Event dates:** Tuesday 11th – Wednesday 12th September 2018. Please note that this event is held in conjunction with **Australian Junior International 2018** (a BWF sanctioned event) which will take place on Thursday 13th – Sunday 16th September 2018 at the same venue.
- Venue:** Kingsway Indoor Stadium (130 Kingsway, Madeley WA 6065, Australia).
Court surface is wood sprung floor.
- Prize money:** No prize money is offered.
- How to enter:** Entries are accepted online on Tournament Software. Online entry short link for entries: <https://goo.gl/GT5F8z> (case-sensitive). BWF Member ID numbers are required for all the players in the team.
- Entry fees:** AUD\$350 per team. Member Associations will be invoiced on Monday 27th August 2018, payment due by Friday 31st August 2018. No refunds for withdrawal will be given.
- Eligibility:** Players must be under 19 years of age (born on 1st January 2000 or later).
To be included in a team of a Member Association (country), a player shall

have residency or citizenship or visa of that country and be in good standing with the Member Association of that country.

- Draw Size:** Maximum number of teams in the tournament is 16.
- Teams per Country:** Each BWF Member Association (country) may enter no more than 2 teams. If entering 2 teams, the Team Managers must indicate the rank of each team order of relative strength in the respective field during the online entry process (team number 1 being the strongest).
- Team Composition:** Each team shall be composed of a minimum of two (2) male and two (2) female players up to a maximum of four (4) male and four (4) female players.
- Team Tie Format:** 1 * Men's Singles (MS), 1 * Women's Singles (WS), 1 * Men's Doubles (MD), 1 * Women's Doubles (WD), 1 * Mixed Doubles (XD). In group play, all five matches of each tie shall be played. In non-group play, each tie shall be stopped when the tie is decided.
- Tie Composition:** Each Team Manager shall hand to the Referee at least two hours before the start of the tie, composition of the team for the tie. The Referee shall, when both teams have been received, make them available to the Team Managers. No Player shall play in more than two matches in a tie.
- Order of Play:** The following are permissible orders of play:
1. MD-WS-MS-WD-XD. 2. MS-WS-MD-WD-XD. 3. XD-MS-MD-WS-WD.
4. XD-MS-WS-MD-WD. 5. XD-WS-MS-WD-MD. 6. WS-MS-WD-MD-XD
7. MD-WD-MS-WS-XD.
Orders of play #1 to #7 will be considered in turn and the first order of play will be used which has no player playing two consecutive matches or playing doubles before singles. If all six orders of play result in a player playing two consecutive matches or playing doubles before singles, order of play #2 will be used.
- Substitutions:** Should a player become injured or indisposed, and thereby unable to play in the team nominated at any time between submission of the team and the scheduled commencement of play, the team concerned shall be permitted, subject to the approval of the Referee, to submit a new team. A substitute may be requested due to illness or injury sustained since teams were nominated, or during the tie. Any pair unaffected by the need for substitution shall be left unchanged. A player substituted during a tie shall take no further part in that tie.

The schedule is provisional and may be changed at the discretion of the Referee. Any player is entitled to minimum 30 minutes interval between two matches as per BWF JCR, clause 3.3.

Presentation:

All prize giving ceremonies will take place on Wednesday at the conclusion of the last round of play.

Practice Courts:

Practice courts at the competition venue will be available from Monday 10th September 2018. Please complete the Practice Courts Booking Form and email it to aji2018@badmintonwa.org.au.

Shuttles:

Aeroplane Black EG1130, two speeds (51 & 52) will be available. Each team will be provided with one dozen practice shuttles free of charge. Additional shuttles may be purchased from the Organiser.

Clothing:

Clothing and advertising requirements according to BWF JCR. **Country name on the shirt is mandatory (BWF Statutes Section 5.3.7).** Player name is optional but if present, it must comply with the BWF JCR. A team must wear the same colour of shirts and shorts/skirts during a tie.

Doping Control:

The BWF Anti-Doping Regulations apply (www.bwfcorporate.com/integrity/anti-doping/). Players competing in this tournament are subject to drug testing by the Australian Sports Anti-Doping Authority (ASADA). Applicable rules, list of prohibited substances and methods, and the "check your substances" tool is available at www.asada.gov.au.

- Accommodation:** Official tournament hotel is Quality Resort Sorrento Beach – please see next page.
- Transportation:** Please arrange to arrive to the Perth International Airport. Airport transfers for arrival and for departure will be provided for players and team officials staying at the tournament hotel (Quality Resort Sorrento Beach). Transport Request Form must be emailed to aji2018@badmintonwa.org.au no later than Thursday 6th September 2018.
Daily bus transfers between the tournament hotel and the stadium will be organised, with schedule displayed at the tournament hotel and at the stadium.

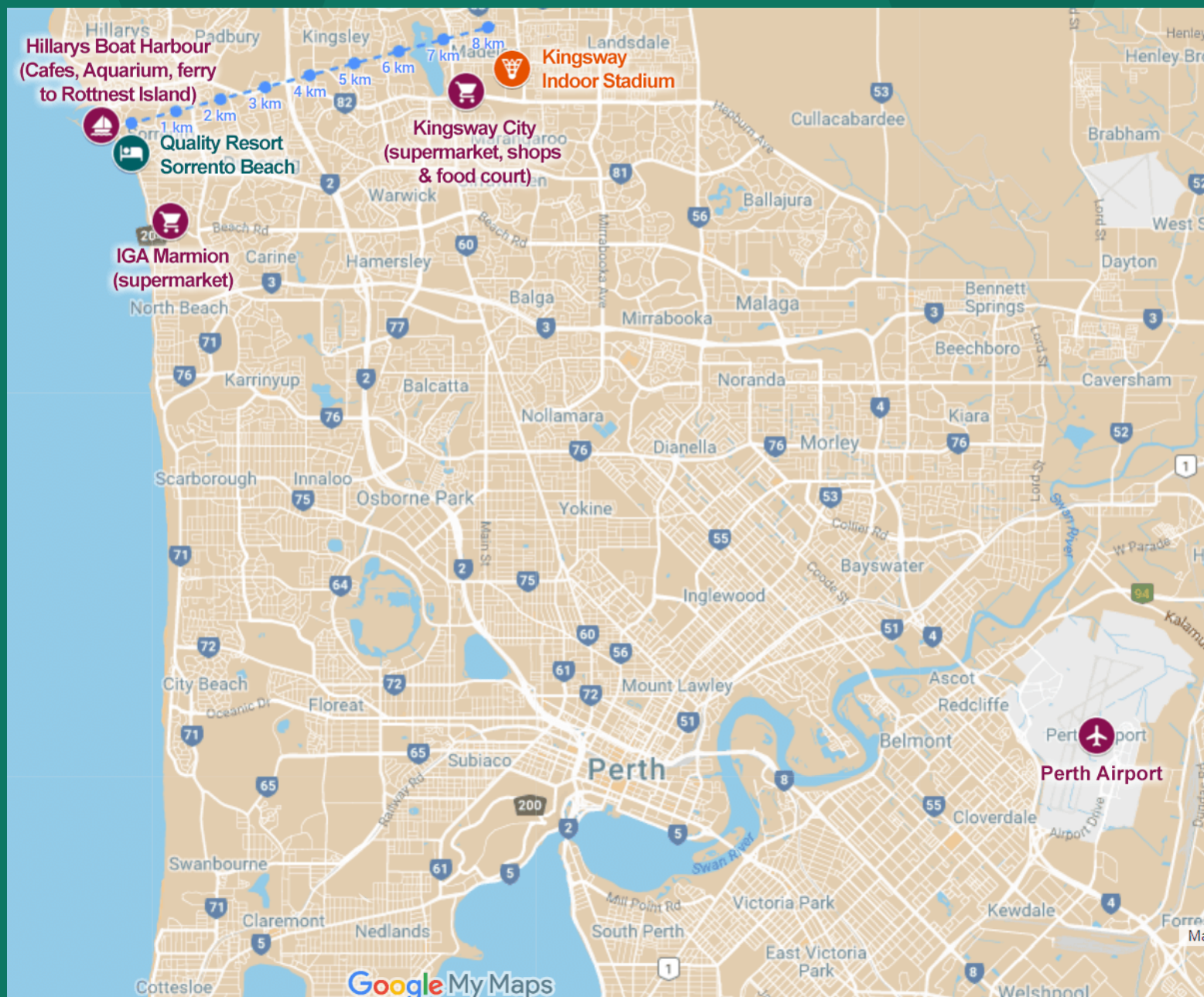

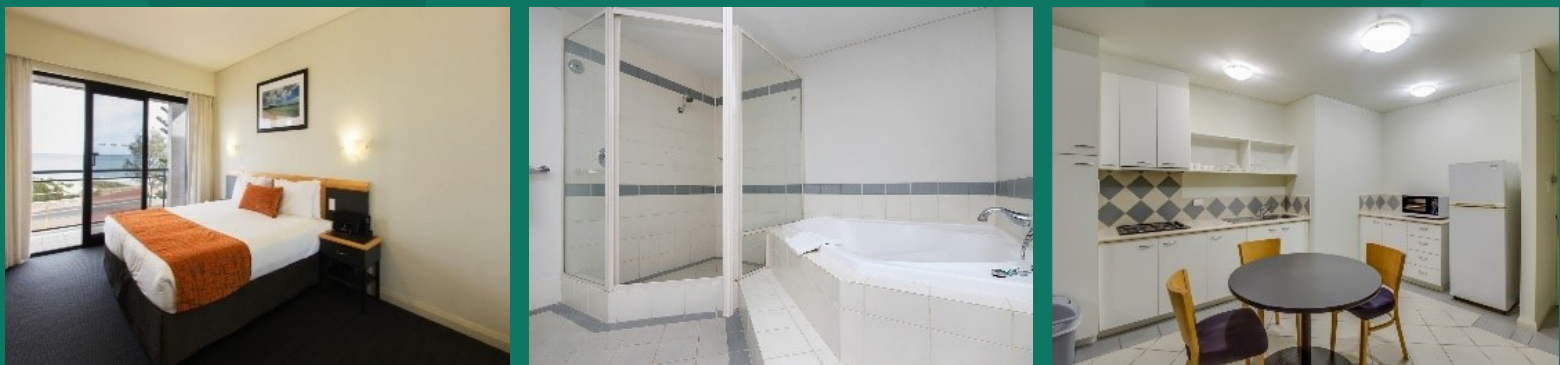
